This letter is sent in accordance to the Semi-Annual Progress Report under the conditions of NPDES general permit NER30000. The letter is in reference to SWMP implementation progress, during the 2007 reporting period, January 1<sup>st</sup> thru June 30<sup>th</sup>.

It is the City of Lexington's feeling that BMP's under the first two years of compliance are currently being addressed in accordance with our SWMP timeline. Along with the development of multiple educational programs, ordinances, and municipal practices efforts are being made to combine resources with other Phase II communities. It is our feeling that combining efforts with other MS4s will be a good opportunity to combine the expertise of all communities in an attempt to meet our NPDES permit requirements and to do so with limited budgets.
