A Regular Meeting of the Lexington City Council was held Tuesday, Tuesday, June 25, 2019, at the Lexington City Hall, 406 E. 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Lexington, Nebraska at 5:30 p.m. Members of the Council present were John Fagot, John Salem, Dora Vivas, Steve Smith and Jeremy Roberts. ## **RESOLUTION NO. 2019-10**

WHEREAS, the City of Lexington owns certain real estate for the purpose of residential development; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Agency of Lexington, Nebraska is preparing a redevelopment project involving the same real estate, and it is in the best interest of the City to aid and cooperate in the planning, undertaking and carrying out of said redevelopment project by transferring title to said real estate to the Community Development Agency.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, as follows:

That the President of the Council is hereby directed and authorized on behalf of the City of Lexington, to execute a Deed, transferring to the Community Development Agency of Lexington, Nebraska, the following described real estate, to-wit:

Lots 21-26, all in Block Ten (10), Southwest First Addition, an addition to the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska; and

Lots 15-20, all in Block 9, Southwest Second Subdivision, a replat of Block 2 and Block 9, Southwest First Addition, an addition to the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska.

## Passed and approved the 25th day of June, 2019.
