ORDINANCE NO. 162

An ordinance vacating that part of 12th street between Blocks "A" and "H" of MacColl and Leflang's Addition and Mac--coll and Leflang's 3rd Addition to the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and the North 75 feet of the alley, running north and south, in said Block "H" and the south 250 feet of the alley, running north and south, in said Block "A".

Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska.

Section 1. The City School Board of the City Schools of Lexington, being the owners of the above described premises, and having filed a petition with the Mayor and City Council to have that part of 12th street between Blocks "A" and "H" in MacColl and Leflang's Addition and MacColl and Leflang's 3rd Addition to the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and the North 75 feet of the alley, running north and south, in said Block "H" and the south 250 feet of the alley, running north and south, in said Block "A" vacated, and it appearing to the Mayor and City Council that the vacating of that part of said street and alley will be of value to the owner of that part of said Block "A" and "H", and no damage to abutting property owners.

Section 2. It is therefore ordered that all that part of 12th street between said Block "A" and "H" and the north 75 feet of said alley, running north and south, in said Block "H" and the south 250 feet of said alley, running north and south, in said Block "A" all in MacColl and Leflang's Addition and MacColl and Leflang's 3rd Addition to the City of Lexington, Nebraska, be and same is hereby vacated, reserving the right of way or easment, for sewer and water pipe lines over and across where said streets and alleys now exist.

Passed and approved this 8th day of September, 1925, and ordered published according to law.
