The Mayor and Council of the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, met in regular special session in the City Hall at 8:00 o'clock P. M., on August 4, 1936 Mayor Kjar presided and City Clerk Olsson recorded

the proceedings of this meeting.

The Mayor instructed the Clerk to call the roll. The Clerk called the roll and the following Councilmen were present: Gillan, Morganson, Hagadone, Spies, Barrett, Evans.

Absent: none.

Whereupon the Mayor announced that the introduction of ordinances was now in order, and the matter now coming before the Mayor and Council was the passage and approval of Ordinance No. 316 of the City of Lexington, Nebraska.

This ordinance was introduced by Councilman Gillan and is in words and figures as follows, to wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 316

An Ordinance amending Section Two (2) of Ordinance No. 199 which was passed and approved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, on June 10, 1929.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

1. That Section Two of Ordinance No. 199 which was passed and approved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska on June 10, 1929, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. All motor vehicles and vehicles of every kind, except ambulances, shall, upon the approach of any of the fire trucks of said City, drive to the curb or out of the main traveled portion of the street or alley, but not within twenty feet of any fire plug or hydrant, and come to a stop and give to said fire trucks a clear right-of-way, and it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to obstruct or in any way interfere with the fire trucks of said City while said trucks are responding to a fire alarm, and it shall be unlawful for any person or persons other than the members of the fire department of said city to drive or park any vehicle within a radius of two City blocks of the location of any such fire."

2. That said original Section No. 2 of Ordinance No. 199 is hereby repealed.
