

ORDINANCE RECORD

CITY HALL LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA

September 1 1936.

The Mayor and Council of the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, met in regular ~~special~~ session in the City Hall at 8:00 o'clock P. M., on September 1, 1936. Mayor Kjar presided and City Clerk Olsson recorded the proceedings of this meeting.

The Mayor instructed the Clerk to call the roll. The Clerk called the roll and the following Councilmen were present: Gillan, Morganson, Hagadone, Spies, Barrett, Evans.

Absent: none.

Whereupon the Mayor announced that the introduction of ordinances was now in order, and the matter now coming before the Mayor and Council was the passage and approval of Ordinance No. 317 of the City of Lexington, Nebraska.

This ordinance was introduced by Councilman Spies and is in words and figures as follows, to wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 317

An Ordinance to amend a resolution which was passed and approved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, on May 28, 1919.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That the resolution declaring the use and occupancy of the streets and sidewalks within the City of Lexington, Nebraska, for the purpose of placing gasoline storage tanks therein, which was passed and approved by the Mayor and Council of said City on May 28, 1919, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Resolved, that the use and occupancy of the street and sidewalk on Washington Street within the City of Lexington, Nebraska, for the purpose of placing gasoline storage tanks therein, and the placing and maintaining of pumps and appliances connected therewith on the sidewalks of said Street, are a nuisance and a dangerous menace and an unlawful obstruction to the use of said street and sidewalks thereof, and the city officers of said city are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to cause such tanks or pumps to be removed forewith from said street and sidewalk and to prohibit the installation of any such pumps or tanks on said Street."

Section 2. Said original resolution be the same and is hereby repealed.
