The Mayor and Council of the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, met in regular special session in the City Hall at 8.00 o'clock P.M., on June 24, 1938. Mayor Kitar presided and City Clerk Olsson recorded

the proceedings of this meeting.

The Mayor instructed the Clerk to call the roll. The Clerk called the roll and the following Councilmen were present: Councilmen Gillan, Seaman, Morgan, Barrett, Evans.

Absent: Councilmen Morganson.

Whereupon the Mayor announced that the introduction of ordinances was now in order, and the matter now coming before the Mayor and Council was the passage and approval of Ordinance No. 338 of the City of Lexington, Nebraska.

This ordinance was introduced by Councilman Gillan and is in words and figures as follows, to wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 338.

AN ORDINANCE prohibiting and making unlawful the use and discharge of air rifles, slingshots, and niggershooters within the corporate limits of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and providing a penalty for the violation thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That any person or persons who shall wantonly or unnecessarily use or discharge any air rifle, slingshot or niggershooter within the corporate limits of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than one dollar \$1.00) nor more than five dollars (\$5.00), together with all costs of prosecution, and shall stand committed to jail until such fine and costs are fully paid.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
