## CITY HALL LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA

The Mayor and Council of the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, met in regular special session in the City Hall at 8 o'clock P M., on 6th day July 1943 Mayor Cook presided and City Clerk Egenberger recorded the proceedings of this meeting.

The Mayor instructed the Clerk to call the roll. The Clerk called the roll and the following Councilmen were present: Stewart, Morganson, Seaman, Lincoln, and Reynolds.

Absent: Beisner.

Whereupon the Mayor announced that the introduction of ordinances was now in order, and the matter now coming before the Mayor and Council was the passage and approval of Ordinance No. 380 of the City of Lexington, Nebraska.

This ordinance was introduced by Councilman Stewart and is in words and figures as follows, to wit:

### ORDINANCE NO. 380

An ordinance making a levy for taxation on all of the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, for the fiscal year 1943, commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1943.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That there is hereby levied on all of the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, for the fiscal year 1943, commencing on the First Tuesday of May, 1943, the following:

General Fund -----	5. Mills
Maintenance of Fire Department -----	.4 Mills
Fire Department Equipment -----	.3 Mills
Sewer Maintenance -----	.4 Mills
Amusements -----	.3 Mills
Electric Lights and Power -----	2.5 Mills
City Park Fund -----	.5 Mills
City Library Fund -----	1. Mills
Cemetery Fund -----	1. Mills
Interest and Sinking Fund on Water Refunding Bonds -----	1. Mills
Interest and Sinking Fund on District Paving and Refunding Bonds -----	9. Mills
Total -----	21.4 Mills
