## CITY HALL LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA

The Mayor and Council of the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, met in regular special session in the City Hall at Eight o'clock P M., on July 2, 1946, Mayor William A. Stewart, Jr. presided and City Clerk A.R. Kirkpatrick recorded the proceedings of this meeting.

The Mayor instructed the Clerk to call the roll. The Clerk called the roll and the following Councilmen were present:

W. R. Smith, M. Morganson, W. R. Hemelstrand, M. E. Hebrew, and R. R. Reutlinger.

Absent: Paul McGuire

Whereupon the Mayor announced that the introduction of ordinances was now in order, and the matter now coming before the Mayor and Council was the passage and approval of Ordinance No. 423 of the City of Lexington, Nebraska.

This ordinance was introduced by Councilman Reutlinger and is in words and figures as follows, to wit:

### ORDINANCE NO. 423

#### ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL

An Ordinance appropriating money of the City of Lexington Dawson County, Nebraska, for the purpose of paying liabilities, current expenses and for necessary improvements for the fiscal year 1946.

BE ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of money to be raised by general levy of taxes upon all property within the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and of money now on hand and money to be received from collection of water rent, for the purpose of paying present liabilities, current expenses, and for necessary improvements and expenses of said city for the fiscal year 1946, the following sums of money, to wit:

Maintenance, Improvement and Extension of Water Works	20,000.00
Maintenance of Fire Department	3,500.00
Fire Department Equipment	2,500.00
Sewer Maintenance	3,000.00
Amusements	3,000.00
Electric Lights and Power	9,500.00
City Park Fund	4,000.00
City Library Fund	5,000.00
Cemetery Fund	4,000.00
Interest and Sinking Fund on Water Refunding Bonds	2,500.00
Interest and Sinking Fund on District Paving and Refunding Bonds	20,000.00
Interest and Sinking Fund on Aviation Field Bonds	2,500.00
Road Fund	8,500.00
TOTAL	\$ 108,500.00
