And the matter now coming before the Mayor and Council was the passage and approval of Ordinance No. of the City of Nebraska. This ordinance was introduced by Councilman , and is in words and figures as follows, to-wit:

### ORDINANCE NO. 450

An Ordinance to amend Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 383 which was passed and approved on August 3, 1943, as amended by Ordinance No. 437, which was passed and approved on the 6th day of May, 1947, to regulate the production, transportation, processing, handling, sampling, examination, grading, labeling, regrading, and sale of milk and milk products; the inspecting of diary herds, dairies and milk plants; the issuing and revocation of parmits to milk producers and distributors; the placarding of restaurants and other establishments serving milk and milk products; and providing penalties for violation of the provisions of said Ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL of the City of Kexington, Nebreske:

Section 1. That Section 1 of original Ordinance No. 383, as amended by Section 1 Ordinance No. 437 be amended to read as follows: "Section 1. The production, transportation, processing, handling,"

sempling, examination, guading, labeling, recording and sale of all milh and milh products sold for ultimate consumption within the City of Lexington, Nebratha, or its volice jurisdiction, the inspection of dairy hards, salaries and milk plants, the issuing and revocation of permits to producers and distributors, the placerding of restamants and other establishments serving milh and wilk products providing for the collection of fees, and the providing of penaltics for the violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be regulated in accordance with the terms of the unabridged form of the 1939 edition of the United States Public health Service Hilb Ordinance, three (1) copies of which shall be on file in the office of the City Clerk; Provided, that the blank apaces following the words "City of" in said unabridged form shall be understood to refer to the City of Lexington, Nebrasks; Provided further, that Section 8, 16, and 17, of said unabridged form shall be replaced respectively by Sections 1,3, and 4 of said original Ordinance No. 383, as emended."

Section 2. That Section 2 of original Ordinance No. 383, as smended by Section 1 of Ordinance No. 430 be smended to read as follows:

"Section 2. From and ofter ten (10) days from date on which this Ordinance takes effect, no milk or milk products shall be sold to the finalcondumer, or to restaurants, sode fountains, grocery stores, or similar establishments except GradeA; Provided, that when any milk distributor dails to outlify for the above grade the Health Officer is authorized to revoke his permit or in lieu thereof to degrade his products for at least seven (7) days and permit its aske during a temporary period not exceeding thirty (30) days or in emergencies for such longer pariod as he may deem necessary."

Section 3. Shid original Sections 1 and 1 of Ordinance No. 537 are hereby recorded.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and shall become effective immediately after its passage and approvel as required by law.
