## ORDINANCE NO. 505

An ordinance to amend Section Two of Article I of Chapter Ten of the Municipal Code of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, as amended by Ordinance No. 406 which was passed and approved on October 9, 1945; and to amend Section One of Article VI of Chapter Ten of the Municipal Code of said City which was passed and approved on April 7, 1943.

Be it ordained by the President of the Council and the Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska:

SECTION 1. That Section Two of Article I of Chapter Ten of the Municipal Code of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, as amended by Ordinance No. 406 of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, which was passed and approved by the Mayor and Council of said City on October 9. 1945, shall be amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. WHERE LAID .-- That all sidewalks outside of the business district of said city shall be laid two (2) feet from the lot line, and the space between the lot line and the sidewalk shall be graded up to the level of the sidewalk. Provided, however, that on any street which is paved or curbed, guttered (or) graveled, said sidewalk may be laid next to and abutting the curb along the entire side of any one block, by agreement of all the property owners owning property abutting on said street in said block; and where said sidewalk is to be laid next to the curb as herein provided, a written agreement shall be executed by all the owners of property abutting on said street along the side of the block proposed to be so improved, agreeing to the construction of such sidewalk along the curb in said block, which agreement shall be filed with the City Clerk, and the City Council shall, by motion, if such agreement is properly executed and filed, authorize the construction of the same as provided in Article I of Chapter Ten of the Municipal Code of said city. Provided further, all sidewalks to be constructed along the curb as provided herein shall be constructed in strict accordance with plans and specifications to be furnished by the City Manager of said City."

SECTION 2. That Section One of Article VI of Chapter Ten of the Municipal Code of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, which was passed and approved by the Mayor and Council of said City on April 7, 1943, shall be amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. VIOLATION, PENALTY. -- Every person who shall violate, neglect or refuse to comply with, or who resists or opposes the enforcement of any of the provisions of Chapter Ten of the Municipal Code of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not to exceed \$100.00 for each offense, and shall stand committed to the City or County jail until such fine and the costs of prosecution are fully paid."

SECTION 3. That Ordinance No. 406 of the City of Lexington, and Section One of Article VI of Chapter Ten of the Municipal Code of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, are hereby repealed.
