

ORDINANCE NO. 511

An ordinance to amend Subparagraph (a) of Section 3 of Ordinance No. 379 which was passed and approved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska on June 1, 1943.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:


SECTION 1. That Subparagraph (a) of Section 3 of Ordinance No. 379 of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, which was passed and approved by the Mayor and Council of said City on June 1, 1943 be amended to read as follows:

"Section 3, Garbage Can Capacity and Regulations:


(a) It shall be the duty of every housekeeper or occupant of any building in the city of Lexington, and the proprietor of any restaurant, cafe, boarding-house, eatinghouse, or commission-house, and grocery stores to place and deposit their garbage in a suitable, watertight, sheet iron or galvanized can, with handles, of not more than 10 gallons capacity with tight covers, said can and cover to be provided at their own expense, and to place such receptacle near the alley in the rear of their premises or at some other place reasonably accessible to the collector of garbage."

SECTION 2. That said Subparagraph (a) of Section 3 of Ordinance No. 379 of the City of Lexington be and the same is hereby repealed.
