

ORDINANCE NO. 550

An Ordinance regulating the use of the streets of the City of Lexington for parking in front of or adjacent to the entrance to theaters and hotels; defining the word "hotels" as used herein; providing penalties for the violation of the provisions hereof; and to repeal all Ordinances in conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON:

1. HOTEL. DEFINITION OF. The word "hotel" or "hotels" as used herein shall be construed to mean and include any hotel which shall have at least Twenty (20) rooms or more for rental purposes.


2. HOTELS. Subject to the approval of the City Manager of said City of Lexington, parking space may be reserved near the entrance of hotels for such number of parking stalls as may be designated by the City Manager, and parking in such designated stall shall be limited to Ten (10) minutes. Prior to the effective provisions hereof, the Proprietor of any hotel as defined herein, shall, at his own expense, install a suitable sign approved by the City Manager designating the parking stalls reserved for limited parking. Approval of such parking limitation shall be prepared in writing and made a part of the records of said City and the City Manager is hereby granted the right to revoke such reservation at any time or to change or amend the provisions therefor. No sign for limited parking shall be placed or erected except as designated and approved by the City Manager.

3. THEATERS. No parking shall hereafter be allowed across the entire front of any theater of said City during the period of one hour before the commencement of any theater performance and one hour after the completion of such performance. Necessary signs to prohibit such parking shall be provided and installed by the owner or operator of such theater. Any and all signs used for such purposes shall be approved by the City Manager.

4. VIOLATION, PENALTY. Any person, firm, corporation or any agent, servant or employees thereof, violating any provisions of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) or more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each offense, and such person or persons shall stand committed to the City ~~or~~ County Jail until such fine and costs of prosecution are fully paid.


5. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
