ORDINANCE NO.572

An Ordinance to amend Section 1 of Article II, Chapter 1 of the Municipal Code of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, by making it unlawful for any person, persons, firm or corporation, to keep any horses, cattle, hogs, sheep or goats at any place within the corporate limits of the City of Lexington, within one hundred (100) feet of any dwelling house in said City.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Article II, Chapter I of the Municipal Code of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, be ammended to read as follows:

"Section 1.- STALLIONS, JACKS, etc., KEEPING REGULATED.That it is hereby declared to be unlawful for any person,
persons, firm or corporation, either by themselves, their
agents, servants or employees, to keep any stallion, stallions, jack, jacks, bull or bulls at any place within the
corporate limits of the City of Lexington, Nebraska,
within six hundred (600) feet of any dwelling house in
said city, and it is further declared to be unlawful for
any person, persons, firm or corporation, either by
themselves, their agents, servants ork employees, to keep
any horse, horses, cow, cattle, hog, hogs, sheep, goat
or goats within the corporate limits of the City of
Lexington, Nebraska, within one hundred (100) feet of
any dwelling house in said City."
