

ORDINANCE NO. 575

An Ordinance to amend Section 10 of Ordinance No. 560 of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, which was passed and approved on December 20, 1949, providing a penalty for the violation of Sections 5 and 6 of Ordinance No. 560 for the regulation of parking meters and parking meter zones.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Section 10 of Ordinance No. 560 of the City of Lexington, which was passed and approved on December 20, 1949, be amended to read as follows:

"Section 10. Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate, or who shall permit or allow anyone to violate any of the provisions of Sections Five (5) and Six (6) of this ordinance (relative to manner, time and limits for parking in parking meter zone), shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall upon conviction thereof, be fined in the sum of Fifty Cents, and shall be assessed costs in the sum of Fifty Cents.

Provided however, that for the first and second violations of any part of said sections, such person, firm or corporation may, in lieu of the fine and costs as herein provided, appear at the Police Station in said City of Lexington and upon presentation of ticket for violation to any police officer and the deposit of Five Cents in the Parking Meter in said Police Station, ~~penalty for said violation shall be satisfied~~ within twenty-four hours after the issuance of such ticket for violation, penalty for said violation shall be satisfied."

Section 2. Said original Section 10 of Ordinance No. 560 of the City of Lexington is hereby repealed.
