ORDINANCE NO. 581

AN ORDINANCE providing that members of the Volunteer Fire Department of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, shall be considered as acting in the performance and within the scope of their duties in fighting fire, or saving property or life, outside of the corporate limits of such city, when directed to do so by Chief, or authorized person, and to repeal all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict therewith.

WHEREAS; The Volunteer Fire Department of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, has been regularly organized under the laws of the State of Nebraska, and :

WHEREAS: The City of Lexington, Nebraska, deems it necessary and expedient for such Volunteer Fire Department to go beyond the corporate limits of such city for the fighting of fire or saving life or property.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF Lexington, Nebraska,

SECTION 1. That the Volunteer Fireman of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, shall be considered as acting in the performance and within the scope of their duties in fighting fire or saving property or life, outside the corporate limits of such city, when directed to do so by the Chief of such Fire Department or some person authorized to act for such Chief.

SECTION 11. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 111. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
