## ORDINANCE NUMBER 617.

An Ordinance creating Voting Districts within the City of Lexington, Nebraska, designating the boundaries thereof and providing for the designation of polling places within each of said voting districts.

BH IT OFDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, MEDIASKA:

Section 1. The City of Lexington, Nebraska, is hereby divided into Five (5) Voting Districts to be designated and bounded as follows:

VOTING DISTRICT NUMBER ONE shall include all that part of said City lying north of the center line of the Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way, east of the east line of Washington Street and south of 10th Street.

VOTING DISTRICT NUMBER TWO shall include all that part of said City lying north of 10th Street and east of the east line of Washington Street.

VOTING DISTRICT NUMBER THUME shall include all that part of said City lying north of 10th Street and west of the east line of Washington Street.

VOTING DISTRICT HUBER FOUR shall include all that part of said City lying north of the center line of the Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way, west of the east line of Washington Street and south of 10th Street.

VOTING DISTRICT NUMBER FIVE shall include all that part of said City lying south of the center line of the Union Pacific Rail-road right-of-way.

Section 2. Voting or polling places within each of said voting districts shall be designated by the City Council, and not more than Twenty (20) days nor less than Ten (10) days prior to the time of holding any City Election, the Council of said City shall cause Notice to be published in some newspaper of general circulation in said City, stating the time at which said Election shall be held, the Officers to be elected or nominated, and designating the voting place for each voting district.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
