## ORDINANCE NO. 679

AN ORDINANCE GOVERNING THE INSTALLATION, OPERATING, REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF TELEVISION OR RADIO RECEIVING OR TRANSMITTING ANTENNAS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF INSTALLATION PERMITS, PROVIDING FOR THE INSPECTION AND APPROVAL OF THE INSTALLATIONS BY THE CITY, PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Any person, firm, corporation, or legal entity, building or erecting an out-door mast or antenna, radio or television, shall first make an application to the City Clerk of the City of Lexington for an installation permit, before commencing the building or erecting such antenna.

Section 2. Upon the receipt of the application for permit, the City Manager shall issue the permit under rules and regulations of the City Council, duly adopted for the erection, installation, operation, repair and maintenance of said out-door masts and antennas, and for the inspection of said installations by the said City Manager or his duly appointed representative.

Section 3. No fee shall be charged for permit or for inspection.

Section 4. Each applicant for a permit shall agree to abide by the rules and regulations and inspection required by the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska.

Section 5. Any person, firm, corporation, or legal entity, violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, or who erects or maintains an out-door mast or antenna without first obtaining a permit therefore, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) no less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) and each day that such person, firm, corporation, or legal entity shall violate this ordinance, such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 6. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
