

ORDINANCE NO. 699

AN ORDINANCE CREATING PAVING AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 12, AND PROVIDING FOR CURB AND GUTTER, GRADING, DRAINAGE, GRAVELING AND PAVING THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

Section 1. That there is hereby created within said City an improvement district, to be known as "Paving and Improvement District No. 12."

Section 2. That said Improvement District shall consist of that part of 7th Street from Lincoln to Harrison Street; that part of Harrison Street from 7th Street to 8th Street; that part of Harrison Street from 6th Street to U. S. Highway Number 30; that part of 6th Street from Madison Street to Taylor Street; that part of Taylor Street from 6th Street to U. S. Highway Number 30; and that part of Johnson Street from 6th Street to U. S. Highway Number 30.

Section 3. That there ^{shall} ~~should~~ be constructed and provided on that part of 7th Street from Lincoln to Harrison Street; that part of Harrison Street from 7th Street to 8th Street; that part of Harrison Street from 6th Street to U. S. Highway Number 30; and that part of 6th Street from Madison Street to Taylor Street, paving, curb, gutter and drainage as needed; that the paving, curbing, guttering and drainage shall be in accordance with plans, specifications and estimates to be hereafter adopted.

Section 4. That there shall be constructed and provided on that part of Taylor Street from 6th Street to U. S. Highway Number 30 and that part of Johnson Street from 6th Street to U. S. Highway Number 30, curb and guttering, grading, drainage and gravel ~~and~~ as needed; that the curb and guttering, grading, drainage and graveling shall be in accordance with plans, specifications and estimates to be hereafter adopted.

Section 5. That the streets provided in the above sections will abut on paving, curb, guttering and graveling, already laid.

Section 6. That the cost of such curbing and guttering, drainage, grading and graveling, and paving, except street and alley intersections, shall be assessed against the lots and tracts of land abutting said portions of streets, specifically benefited thereby, in proportion to the benefits received, to be determined by the City Council as provided by law.
