ordinance no. 732

AN ORDINANCE CREATING SEWER AND LATERAL DISTRICT NO. 59, PROVIDING FOR CONSTRUCTION OF LATERALS THEREIN, AND PROVIDING FOR ASSESSMENTS THEREFORE AGAINST THE ABUTTING PROPERTIES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That there is hereby created within said City, a

Sewer Lateral District, to be known as "Sewer Lateral District Number 59."

Section 2. That the said Sewer Lateral District shall consist of the parts and portions of lots and tracts of land in the City of Lexington, benefitting therefrom, to-wit: All of the lots in Block Ten (10) in Stuckey and Little's Addition, and all of Blocks Six (6), Seven (7) and Eight (8) in James Ervin Second Subdivision; said lots and blocks abut Oak Street from Washington Street to Madison Street and from Harrison Street to Block Nine (9) of James Ervin Second Subdivision on the south side of said street.

Section 3. That there shall be constructed and provided in said street sewer laterals, in accordance with plans, specifications, and estimates to be hereafter adopted.

Section 4. That the cost of such Sewer Laterals shall be assessed against the parts and portions of lots and tracts of land abutting said portion of street, specifically benefited thereby in proportion to the benefits received, to be determined by the City Council as provided by law.
