ORDINANCE NO. 835

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 8-204 OF CHAPTER EIGHT,
ARTICLE II OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON,
NEBRASKA, RELATING TO THE KEEPING OF ANIMALS, FOWLS AND BEES
WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Section 8-204 of the Municipal Code of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, be amended to read as follows:

8-204. It is hereby declared to be unlawful for any person, persons, firm or corporation, either by themselves, their agents, servants or employees, to keep any stallion, jack, see bull, or beehive, at any place within the corporate limits of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, within six hundred (600) feet of any dwelling house in said city, or to keep any horse, cow, hog, sheep, or goat within the corporate limits of said City within One Hundred (100) feet of any dwelling house in said City.

Section 2. That the original Section 8-204 of the Municipal Code of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, is repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
