

ORDINANCE NO. 928

AN ORDINANCE CREATING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 81
AND PROVIDING FOR GRADING, DRAINAGE AND PAVING THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

Section 1. That there is hereby created within the City
an Improvement District known as "Improvement District No. 81".

Section 2. That said Improvement District shall consist
of the alley from Jackson Street to Grant Street between ~~5th~~^{6th} and ~~6th~~^{7th}
Streets.

Section 3. That there shall be constructed and provided
on the alley between Jackson and Grant Streets between ~~5th~~^{6th} and ~~6th~~^{7th}
Streets grading, drainage and paving as needed and that the paving,
drainage and grading as needed shall be in accordance with plans,
specifications and estimates to be hereafter adopted.

Section 4. That the alleys will abut on the concrete
paving and sidewalks already laid.

Section 5. That the cost of such grading, drainage and
paving shall be assessed against the lots and tracts of land abutting
said portion of the alley, specifically benefited thereby in proportion
to the benefits received, to be determined by the City Council as
provided by law.
