

ORDINANCE NO. 944

AN ORDINANCE CREATING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 89 AND PROVIDING FOR CURB, GUTTER, GRAVEL, GRADING AND DRAINAGE THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby created within the City an improvement district to be known as "IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 89."

SECTION 2. That the said Improvement District shall consist of that portion of Oak Street from Washington Street to Harrison Street and the property abutting and adjacent thereto and benefited thereby, as by law provided.

SECTION 3. That there shall be constructed and provided on that portion of Oak Street from Washington Street to Harrison Street curb, gutter, gravel, grading and drainage as needed; that the curb, gutter, gravel, grading and drainage shall be in accordance with plans, specifications and estimates to be hereafter adopted.

SECTION 4. That the street provided in the above section will abut on concrete paving or curb and gutter already laid.

SECTION 5. That the cost of such curb, gutter, gravel, grading and drainage except street and alley intersections, shall be assessed against the lots and tracts of land abutting upon and adjacent to the said portion of streets, specifically benefited thereby, in proportion to the benefits received, to be determined by the City Council as by law provided.
