ORDINANCE NO. 999

AN ORDINANCE CREATING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. //O AND PRO-VIDING FOR CONCRETE PAVING AND GRADING THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. Under the authority of Legislative Bill 243, Session Laws of Nebraska, that there is hereby created within the City an Improvement District to be known as "IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. <u>////</u>".

SECTION 2. That the said Improvement District shall consist of that portion of Monroe Street from 3rd Street to Highway #30, and the property abutting and adjacent thereto and benefited thereby, as by law provided.

SECTION 3. That there shall be constructed and provided on that portion of Monroe Street from 3rd Street to Highway #30, concrete paving and grading as needed; that the concrete paving and grading shall be in accordance with plans, specifications and estimates to be hereafter adopted.

SECTION 4. That the street provided in the above section will abut on concrete paving or curb and gutter already laid.

SECTION 5. That the cost of such concrete paving and grading except street and alley intersections, shall be assessed against the lots and tracts of land abutting upon and adjacent to the said portion of streets, specifically benefited hereby, in proportion to the benefits received to be determined by the City Council as by law provided.
