ORDINANCE NO. 1016

AN ORDINANCE CREATING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 116 AND PROVIDING FOR CONCRETE PAVING AND GRADING THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE AMERICAN COUNTY, COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby created within the City an improvement district to be known as "IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 116."

SECTION 2. That the said Improvement District shall consist of that portion of West 10th Street from Adams Street to Lake Street and Lake Street from 10th Street to 11th Street and the property abutting and adjacent thereto and benefited thereby, as by law provided.

SECTION 3. That there shall be constructed and provided on that portion of West 10th Street from Adams Street to Lake Street and Lake Street from 10th Street to 11th Street paving and grading as needed; that the paving and grading shall be in accordance with plans, specifications and estimates to be hereafter adopted.

SECTION 4. That the street provided in the above section will abut on concrete paving or curb and gutter already laid.

SECTION 5. That the cost of such paving and grading except street and alley intersections, shall be assessed against the lots and tracts of land abutting upon and adjacent to the said portion of streets, specifically benefited thereby, in proportion to the benefits received, to be determined by the City Council as by law provided.
