## ORDINANCE NO. 1050

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9-205 OF CHAPTER NINE (9), ARTICLE TWO

(2) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, PROVIDING FOR THE

DESIGNATION OF STREETS FOR CERTAIN TRAFFIC PURPOSES, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES

IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON:

Section 1. Section 9-205 of the Municipal Code of the City of Lexington is hereby amended to read as follows:

"9-205.01 TRAFFIC-Streets, Designated as Through. Those streets and parts of streets described in Schedule III are hereby declared to be through streets for the purpose of this section.

"9-205.02 TRAFFIC-Streets, Designated as One-way. Those streets and parts of streets described in Schedule IX are hereby declared to be One-way streets for the purpose of this section, and traffic shall move only in the direction provided."

Section 21 Schedule IX shall be as follows but may be changed at future times by resolutions as provided by the Municipal Code.

## "SCHEDULE IX

## (One-way Streets)

- A. One-way streets with traffic moving north only:

  Washington Street from Pacific Street to Seventh (7th) Street.
- B. One-way Streets with traffic moving south only: Lincoln Street from Seventh (7th) Street to Fifth (5th) Street.
- C. One-way Streets with traffic moving west only: Fourth (4th) Street from Grant Street to Washington Street. Sixth (6th) Street from Grant Street to Lincoln Street.
- D. One-way Streets with traffic moving east only: Fifth (5th) Street from Lincoln Street to Grant Street."

Section 3. That any parts of existing Code or Ordinances in conflict thereto are hereby repealed.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from

and after August 7, 1965 and after its publication as by Law provided.
