## ORDINANCE NO. 1056

AN ORDINANCE vacating the East Forty (40) Feet of the North Two Hundred Seven and Eight Tenths (207.8) Feet and, The East Forty (40) Feet of the North Ninety-Seven and Eight Tenths (97.8) Feet of the South Two Hundred Seven and Eight Tenths (207.8) Feet, and, The East Forty-Three (43) Feet of the South One Hundred Ten (110) Feet, All in Lot One (1), Tract "A" of the Subdivision of the East Half (1/2) of Section Six (6), Township Nine (9), North Range Twenty-one (21) in the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, being a part of the property deeded to the City as shown in Book 97, page 706 and Book 99, page 297 of the Deed Records of Dawson County, Nebraska.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Whereas, the following described property was deeded to the City of Lexington for the purpose of establishing a street and dedicated for that purpose and recorded in Book 97, page 706 and Book 99, page 297 in the Deed Records of Dawson County, Nebraska:

The East Forty (40) Feet of the North Two Hundred Seven and Eight Tenths (207.8) Feet and,

The East Forty (40) Feet of the North Ninety-Seven and Eight Tenths (97.8) Feet of the South Two Hundred Seven and Eight Tenths (207.8) Feet, and

The East Forty-three (43) Feet of the South One Hundred Ten (110) Feet,

All in Lot One (1), Tract "A" of the Subdivision of the East Half  $(\frac{1}{2})$  of Section Six (6), Township Nine (9), North, Range Twenty-one (21) in the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, and

Section 2. Whereas, it is now determined that said described property is not needed for the establishing of a street, now, therefore,

Section 3. The above described property is wholly and entirely vacated, and shall no longer be or constitute any part of the street system of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and the ownership thereof shall be retained

in the name of the city of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska.

Section 4. That this ordinance does not vacate the existing Lake Street abutting and adjacent to the above described property or in anyway infringe on the use of or the width of the said street, which is 72.5 feet.

Section 5. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict hereof shall be and the same hereby are repealed.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
