ORDINANCE NO. 1057

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, TO SELL REAL ESTATE HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED, TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF SALE, AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE AND PUBLICATION THEREOF.

to Francis C. Cumpston and Virginia E. Cumpston, Husband and Wife, as Joint

Tenants with right of survivorship for a consideration of \$100.00 to be paid by the said Francis C. Cumpston and Virginia E. Cumpston, toothe City of Lexington.

Section 4. That the said purchasers shall pay the cost of all publication involved herein.

Section 5. That the purchase and transfers do not vacate the existing Lake Street abutting and adjacent to the above described properties or in any way infringe on the use of or the width of the said street which is 72.5 Feet.
