ORDINANCE NO. 1137

AN ORDINANCE CREATING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 144 AND PROVIDING FOR CONCRETE PAVING AND GRADING THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That there is hereby created within the City of Lexington an Improvement District to be known as "IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 144."

Section 2. That the said Improvement District shall consist of that portion of 11th Street from Harrison Street to Adams Street and 14th Street from Lincoln Street to Harrison Street, and the property abutting and adjacent thereto and benefited thereby as by law provided.

Section 3. That there shall be constructed and provided on that portion of 11th Street from Harrison Street to Adams Street and 14th Street from Lincoln Street to Harrison Street, paving and grading which shall be in accordance with plans, specifications and estimates to be hereafter adopted.

Section 4. That the streets provided in the above section will abut on concrete paving already laid.

Section 5. That the cost of such concrete paving and grading, except street and alley intersections, shall be assessed against the lots and tracts of land abutting upon and adjacent to the said protion of streets, specifically benefited thereby, in proportion to the benefits received, to be determined by the City Council as by law provided.
