ORDINANCE NO. 1142

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5-104, CHAPTER FIVE (5), ARTICLE ONE (1) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AND PROVIDING FOR THE LIMITS OF SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS IN THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND SECTIONS OF SAID CODE IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON:

Section 1. 5-104 ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS - Time Limits of Sale. That Section 5-104, Chapter Five (5), Article One (1) be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: No person shall, within said City, sell at retail any alcoholic liquor, including beer, on the day of any national, state, county or municipal election, including primary election, during the hours the polls are open in said City. No person shall, within said City, sell at retail any alcoholic liquor, including beer, on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday, Memorial Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas; when Memorial Day or Christmas fall on Sunday, the following day shall be considered as a holiday for the purpose of this section. It shall be unlawful for any person to sell alcoholic liquor, including beer, within said City on secular days before 6:00 o'clock A. M. and after 11:00 o'clock P. M. on Monday thru Thursday and after 12:00 o'clock P. M. on Friday and Saturday. It shall further be unlawful to sell beer for consumption on the premises Fifteen (15) minutes prior to the above time limits of 11:00 o'clock P. M. and 12:00 o'clock P. M.

Section 2. That all Ordinances and Sections of said Code in conflict with this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
