## ORDINANCE NO. 1150

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7, ARTICLE TWO (2) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, BY THE ADDITION OF SECTION 7-303 PROVIDING FOR THE PROHIBITION OF ANNOYANCES BY THE USE OF TELEPHONES, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND SECTIONS OF SAID CODE IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON:

Section 1. That Article Two (2) of Chapter Seven (7) be and the same is hereby amended by the addition of the following Section to read as follows:

Section 7-303 OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC PEACE- Willful Annoyance by Use of Telephone Prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person to, within the City of Lexington, Nebraska, wilfully annoy any other person by ringing, or causing to be rung, any telephone bell, or to call, or cause to be called, any person over any telephone for the purpose of annoying such person, or to use profane or obscene language over any telephone in the City of Lexington.

Section 2. That all Ordinances and Sections of said Code in conflict with this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
