ORDINANCE NO. 1162

AN ORDINANCE CREATING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 151 AND PROVIDING FOR CONCRETE PAVING, GRADING AND DRAINAGE THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

Section 1. That there is hereby created within the City an Improvement District to be known as "IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 151."

Section 2. That the said Improvement District shall consist of that portion of Tyler Street from 13th Street to the south boundary of 17th Street, and the property abutting and adjacent thereto and benefited thereby as by law provided.

Section 3. That there shall be constructed and provided on that portion of Tyler Street from 13th Street to the south boundary of 17th Street, paving, grading and drainage which shall be in accordance with plans, specifications and estimates to be hereafter adopted.

Section 4. That the street provided in the above section will abut on concrete paving already laid.

Section 5. That the cost of such concrete paving, grading and drainage, except street and alley intersections, shall be assessed against the lots and tracts of land abutting upon and adjacent to the said portion of streets, specifically benefited thereby, in proportion to the benefits received, to be determined by the City Council as by law provided.
