ORDINANCE NO. 1190

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, TO CREATE SEWER DISTRICT NO. 68, TO PROVIDE FOR CHARGING AND ASSESSING THE COST AGAINST THE LOTS AND LANDS WITHIN SAID DISTRICT, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section i. Section 16-667, Sewer District No. 68. There is hereby created the following described Sewer District No. 68, to - wit: Commencing at the alley between Elm and Vine Streets on Ontario Street west to City limits in said Alley. Also in Block Ten (10) C. L. Erwins Subdivision, to include all lots and lands abutting, all in the City of Lexington, Nebraska. That an 8 inch sewer of vitrified clay pipe with such manholes and other accessories as may be ordered by the City Manager to be laid in said district. That said sewer district is ordered pursuant to Section 16-667, Revised Statutes of Nebraska for 1943 as amended; said construction to be under the supervision of the City Manager, and that the entire cost of said improvements shall be charged and are specially benefited by said improvements according to law.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
