ORDINANCE NO. 1200

AN ORDINANCE CREATING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 155 AND PROVIDING FOR CONCRETE PAVING, GRADING AND DRAINAGE THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

Section 1. That there is hereby created within the City of Lexington an improvement district to be known as "IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 155."

Section 2. That the said Improvement District shall consist of the following streets and portions of street:

Walnut Street from Bridge Street East 20 Rods
Third Street from Jackson Street to Jefferson Street
Third Street from Tyler Street to Monroe Street

Third Street from Tyler Street to Monroe Street Fourth Street from Tyler Street to Monroe Street Twelfth Street from Monroe Street to Fillmore Street

Section 3. That there shall be constructed and provided on the above described streets, paving, grading and drainage which shall be in accordance with plans, specifications and estimates to be hereafter adopted.

Section 4. That the streets provided in the above section will abut on concrete already laid.

Section 5. That the cost of such concrete paving, grading and drainage, except street and alley intersections, shall be assessed against the lots and tracts of land abutting upon and adjacent to the said portion of streets, specifically benefited thereby, in proportion to the benefits received, to be determined by the City Council as by law provided.
