RESOLUTION NO. 1205

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. The Council hereby finds and determines that it is necessary and advisable that the City, under the authority granted by Sections 18-2001 to 18-2003 inclusive, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, as amended, without Petition or creating a street improvement district, cause the following unpaved street with in the City to be improved by grading, curbing, guttering and paving, to-wit:

Taylor Street for a distance of one block (380 feet) North of 13th Street, which improvement shall be known as Street Improvement No. 160.

Section 2. It is further found and determined that the above street be improved in Street Improvement No. 160 is a sidestreet and that said street intersects a paved street which paved street is hereby found to be a major traffic streetwithin the City.

Section 3. The street improvement in Street Improvement No. 160 set out above be and the same is hereby ordered constructed, and that the plans and specifications of the engineer for the City for the construction of the said street improvement, which is on file with the City Clerk, is hereby approved and that said Street Improvement shall be performed under the 1970 contract of the City for Street Improvements, as heretofore signed and that the work so performed shall be broken down in such a manner as will reflect the unit price for such improvements.
