REVISION ORDINANCE NUMBER 1206

An Ordinance of the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, revising all the ordinances of the city; authorizing the publication thereof in book form; prescribing the time when such Ordinance shall become effective and repealing all ordinances in conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

Section 1. That all ordinances of a general and permanent nature comprising the Municipal Code of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, are hereby revised, compiled, codified and authorized to be published in book form with Table of Contents, under the direction and by authority of the President of the Council and Council of the said city.

Section 2. Such revision shall be classified under twenty-eight chapters entitled:

Chapter 1. General Provisions Chapter 15. Chapter 2. Administration Chapter 3. Alcoholic Beverages Chapter 4. Amusements Chapter 5. Animals and Fowl Chapter 6. Buildings Chapter 7. Elections Chapter 21. Chapter 8. Electric Service Chapter 9. Fences, Screen Walls or Plantings Chapter 23. Chapter 10. Finance and Taxation Chapter 11. Fire Protection Chapter 25. Chapter 12. Food and Food Establishments Chapter 13. Hospitals Chapter 14. Housing Standards

Chapter 16. Motor Vehicles and Traffic Chapter 17. Noise Chapter 18. Nuisances

Milk and Milk Products

Chapter 19. Offenses -- Miscellaneous Chapter 20. Parks ' Personnel

Refuse and Garbage Chapter 22. Sewers and Sewage Disposal

Chapter 24. Streets and Sidewalks Trailers and Trailer Camps

Chapter 26. Trees and Shrubs

Chapter 27. Water Chapter 28. Zoning

Section 3. In construing the provisions of this Revision Ordinance the following ordinances shall not be deemed or held to be ordinances of a general or permanent nature, to-wit; Ordinances pertaining to Fiscal Management, vacating streets or alleys, authorizing or directing public improvements, levying taxes or special assessments, annual budgets, granting franchises, any ordinance which by its nature would be considered special.

Section 4. Each chapter and section hereof is hereby declared to be independent of every other chapter, or section, and the invalidity of any chapter or section of this ordinance shall not invalidate any other chapter or section.

Section 5. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 6. The repeal of ordinances as provided by Section 5 hereof, shall not affect any rights, fines, penalties, forfeitures or liabilites incurred or acquired thereunder, or actions involving any of the provisions of such ordinances, or any part thereof, and said ordinances are hereby continued in full force and effect after the passage, approval and publication of this revision for the purpose of such rights, fines, penalties, forfeitures and liabilities or actions thereunder.

Section 7. This revision ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
