ORDINANCE NO. 1208

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX TERRITORY AND TO EXTEND THE CORPORATE LIMITS  
OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON.

WHEREAS, the following described Real Estate, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Blk Three (3)  
Grand Prairie Addition to the City of Lexington,  
Dawson County, Nebraska, thence West One Hundred  
Fifty Feet (150'), thence South parallel to the  
west boundary line of Erie Street to U. S. Highway  
30, thence Southeast to a point where Erie Street  
intersects with the north boundary of Highway 30,  
thence north along the west boundary line of Erie  
Street to the place of beginning all within the  
east one-half of Section Six (6), Township Nine  
(9), Range Twenty-one (21), West of the 6th P. M.  
in Dawson County, Nebraska,

is contiguous and adjacent to the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and is  
suburban in character, and,


WHEREAS, said Real Estate will receive material benefits and advantages

Now be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Lexington,  
Nebraska:


Section 1. That the Real Estate hereinbefore described be, and  
the same is hereby annexed and included within the boundaries and territory  
of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and said lands and the persons residing  
thereon shall hereafter be subject to all of the rules, regulations, ordinances,  
taxes and all other burdens and benefits of other persons and territory included  
within the City of Lexington, Nebraska.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and  
after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
