ORDINANCE NO. 1219

AN ORDINANCE TO CORRECT CONFLICTING PROVISIONS OF THE CITY CODE IN CHAPTER 6, "BUILDINGS", AND AMENDING SECTION 6-4 AND ADDING SECTION 6-20, PROVIDING REQUIREMENTS PRECEDENT TO MOVING BUILDINGS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Section 6-4 of the Code is hereby amended to read: "Sec. 6-4. Same--Fees. Fees are provided by Section 28-58."

Section 2. Section 6-20 is added to Chapter 6 as follows:

"Sec. 6-20. Consent of Property Owners to the Moving of Buildings.

Buildings which are otherwise permitted to be moved shall not be moved unless written consent and approval is signed by all property owners abutting and directly across the street from and three-fourths (3/4) of all property owners within one hundred fifty feet (150') of the lot to which said building is to be moved."

Section 3. That all parts of the Code in conflict with this Ordinance hereby are repealed.
