ORDINANCE NO. 1228

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 24-5 OF THE CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

Section 1. Section 24-5 of the Code is hereby amended to read:
"Sec. 24.5. Assessments of Benefits for Improvements--Amount. For all
Improvement Districts after District #165 the benefits of various categories
of street improvement will be assessed against abutting property owners
at a rate not to exceed that shown in the following tables showing the
front footage cost of each type of street improvement:

- (a) Six inch non--reinforced concrete paving with integral curb.

 40 Feet Back to Back \$9.00
- (b) Six inch non--reinforced concrete paving utilizing existing curb and gutter.

40 Feet Back to Back

7.50

(c) Six inch non--reinforced alley paving
20 Feet Edge to Edge 6

6.20

(d) Concrete Curb and gutter and gravel.

40 Feet Back to Back

3.00

All front footage costs of other widths of paving and curb and gutter shall be interpolated to the nearest ten cents (10c)."

Section 2. That all parts of the Code in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
