ORDINANCE NO. 1235

AN ORDINANCE VACATING BRIDGE STREET BETWEEN THE NORTHERLY LINE OF THE UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY AND THE SOUTHERLY LINE OF THE SAID RIGHT-OF-WAY, CLOSING THE RAILROAD CROSSING AT SUCH LOCATION, AND RESERVING TO THE CITY AN EASEMENT FOR PUBLIC UTILITIES EIGHT FEET (8') ON EITHER SIDE OF THE CENTER LINE OF SAID VACATED STREET, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION, MAINTENANCE AND USE OF PUBLIC UTILITIES UNDER THE RULES AND REGULATIONS AND STATUTES AFFECTING THE USE OF SUCH EASEMENTS AT RAILROAD CROSSINGS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Bridge Street lying between the northerly line of the Union Pacific Railroad Right-of-Way and the southerly line of said Railroad Right-of-Way be and the same is hereby vacated, reserving, however, to the City of Lexington an easement for public utilities eight feet (8') on either side of the center line of said Bridge Street between the said southerly and northerly line of the Railroad Right-of-Way, in accordance with the plat of the City Engineer dated May 21, 1971.

Section 2. The crossing existing at the said described street be and the same is hereby closed.

Section 3. That a copy of this Ordinance be recorded in the Register of Deeds Office of Dawson County, Nebraska.

Section 4. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
