ORDINANCE NO. 1270

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-10 OF THE CODE AND PROVIDING FOR ANNUAL SALARIES FOR THE COUNCIL AND THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Section 2-10 Salaries is hereby amended as follows:

"Sec. 2-10. Salaries. All elective and appointive officers of the city
shall receive annual salaries as provided by statutes, special ordinances
or resolutions. The salary of the city manager and city clerk-treasurer
shall be paid semimonthly. All other appointive and elective officers shall
be paid quarterly.

Beginning June 1, 1974, the annual salary of the council shall be one thousand dollars for the president and six hundred fifty dollars for each of the other councilmen. The present salary of six hundred dollars for the president and four hundred dollars for each of the other councilmen shall continue until that date."

Section 2. All parts of the Code in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
