ORDINANCE NO. 1276

AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY AMENDING SECTION 3-6, SECTION 3-9, AND SECTION 3-10 OF THE CODE AND PROVIDING A CHANGE OF HOURS FOR THE CLOSING OF RETAIL LIQUOR AND BEER STORES, CLOSING OF SUCH STORES ON NAMED HOLIDAYS, PROVIDING FOR ENTERTAINMENT ON THE LICENSED PREMISES, PROVIDING FOR DANCING ON LICENSED PREMISES; SUCH PROVISIONS TO CONTINUE FOR SIX MONTHS AFTER THE ENACTMENT OF THIS ORDINANCE, SUSPENDING THE ORIGINAL SECTIONS FOR THE PERIOD OF SIX MONTHS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That the original Section 3-6, Section 3-9, and Section 3-10 be suspended for a period of six months from the enactment of this Ordinance and the the following temporarily amended sections be enforced during the period of the said six months:

"Sec. 3-6. Hours of sale generally.

No person shall, within the City, sell at retail any alcoholic liquor, including beer, on the day of any national, state, county or municipal election, including primary election, during the hours the polls are open in the City. No person shall, within the City, sell at retail any alcoholic liquor, including beer, on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas. It shall be unlawful for persons holding an exclusive off-sale license to sell alcoholic liquor on the secular days before 6:00 A. M. and after 11:00 P. M. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday and 12:00 P. M. on Friday and Saturday. It shall be unlawful for any person holding on-sale and off-sale license to sell packaged liquor on secular days before 6:00 A. M. and after 11:00 P. M. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday and after 12:00 P. M. on Friday and Saturday and to sell beer in packages after 12:00 P. M. on Monday through Saturday. Persons having an on-sale license may keep their premises open for business on permissable days between the hours of 6:00 A. M. and 12:00 P. M.

Sec. 3-9. Entertainment on licensed premises generally.


It shall be unlawful for any licensee under the Nebraska Liquor Control Act with a place of business within the City to permit, on premises where alcoholic liquors are consumed thereon, entertainments other than:

It shall be lawful for patrons to dance on the premises of an on-sale licensee, when such dancing is supervised by the licensee.

Section 4 and 5. That Section 3-6, Section 3-9, and Section 3-10, of the Code as written prior to the passage of this Court Ordinance, being the same are hereby repealed.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
