ORDINANCE NO. __1295

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE STREET EAST OF BRIDGE STREET LYING BETWEEN BLOCK TWO (2) AND THREE (3) OF JOSEPH SMITH'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. The City street running east from Bridge Street for twenty-three (23) rods, lying between Block Two (2) and Three (3) in Joseph Smith's Addition to the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, is hereby wholly and entirely vacated and shall no longer be or constitute any part of the streets of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and the ownership thereof shall revert to the owners of the adjacent real estate, one-half upon each side thereof.

Section 2. A copy of this Ordinance shall be certified to the office of the Register of Deeds of Dawson County and, at their cost, be recorded by the owner or owners of lots or lands abutting the same.

Section 3. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage, and approval and publication as required by law.
