ORDINANCE NO. 1306

AN ORDINANCE CREATING WATER EXTENSION DISTRICT NO. 2
AND PROVIDING FOR A WATER MAIN THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. There is hereby created within the City,
a Water Extension District, to be known as "Water Extension District
No. 2", consisting of property described as follows, to-wit:

The lots and tracts of land abutting upon and
adjacent to Park Street from 13th Street to 15th
Street.

Section 2. That a six (6) inch cast iron water main
as ordered by the City Manager shall be laid in said District
running generally north to south down the middle of Park Street
in accordance with the plans, specifications, and estimates to
be hereinafter adopted.

Section 3. That the cost of the Water Extension District
shall be assessed against the lots or tracts of land abutting upon
and adjacent to said portion of the street, specifically benefited
thereby in proportion to the benefit received, to be determined by
the City Council as the law provides.
