

ORDINANCE NO. 1311

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 16-41, RELATING TO
SPEED LIMITS: TO ESTABLISH SPEED LIMITS -- 30 MILES PER HOUR:
TO ESTABLISH SPEED LIMITS -- 35 MILES PER HOUR: TO ESTABLISH
SPEED LIMITS -- 40 MILES PER HOUR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 16-41 of the Code is hereby amended
to read as follows:

Sec. 16-41. Same -- Other specific speed
limits.

(a) The speed limit shall be thirty miles
per hour on the following streets or parts of
streets:

Bridge Street and Jackson Street, Maple to
Fifth Street.
Fifth Street, Grant to Jefferson.
Grant Street, Fifth Street to Pacific Avenue.
Jefferson Street, Pacific Avenue to Fifth
Street.

(b) The speed limit shall be thirty-five
miles per hour on the following streets or parts
of streets:

Adams Street, U.S. Highway No. 30 to City
limits north of Twentieth Street.
Pacific Avenue, mid-block between Madison
Street and Lincoln Street to City limits
west of Erie Street.
Pacific Avenue, Taft Street to Jackson Street.
Taft Street, Pacific Avenue to Thirteenth
Street.

(c) The speed limit shall be forty miles
per hour on the following street or part of
street:

Bridge Street, Maple to south City limits.

Section 2. Sec. 16-41, as written prior to the passage
of this Ordinance, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in
force from and after its passage, approval and publication as
required by law.
