

RESOLUTION NO. 1314

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, deems the improvement of Highway No. 30 in and through Lexington, Nebraska, as presented by the plans and specifications at the Corridor and Design public hearing on July 25, 1973, to be an essential and worthwhile improvement to the safety and convenience of the traveling public.


WHEREAS, there were objections to the width and placement of a number of the openings to abutting land, and the State Department of Roads has agreed that they will do everything within their power to change and correct the problems brought up by these objections; and now it appears that there is substantial approval to the improvement of Highway No. 30 by the abutting land owners.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

The plans and specifications for the improvement of Highway No. 30 presented at the Corridor and Design public hearing on July 25, 1973, are hereby accepted and approved, subject to the agreement of the State Department of Roads to do everything within its power to change and correct the problems brought out by the objections to the number and placement of openings into the abutting land.


2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to proceed to bid letting as soon as possible.
