AN ORDINANCE CREATING SEWER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 69,
PROVIDING FOR A SEWER MAIN THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. There is hereby created within the City of
Lexington a Sewer Improvement District to be known as "Sewer
Improvement District No. 69".

Section 2. That the outer boundaries of said Sewer
Improvement District shall be described as follows, to-wit:

A tract of land in the Juhl Addition to the
City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska,
described as follows: Beginning at the northeast
corner of Lot One (1), Block Three (3), in the
Juhl Addition; thence West a distance of Four
Hundred Seventy-five feet (475.0'); thence South
a distance of Six Hundred Ten feet (610'); thence
East a distance of Four Hundred Seventy-five feet
(475.0'); thence North a distance of Six Hundred
Ten feet (610') to the place of beginning.

Section 3. That eight inch (8") clay sewer mains as
ordered by the City Manager shall be laid in the district starting
at the center of Fifteenth Street at the alley of Block Two (2),
Juhl Addition and running West down the center of Fifteenth Street
to the alley of Block Four (4), Juhl Addition, with extensions
therefrom running South down the center of the alleys in Blocks
Three (3) and Four (4), Juhl Addition, and terminating where said
alleys meet Thirteenth Street, which shall be in accordance with
plans, specifications and estimates to be hereinafter adopted.

Section 4. That the cost of the sewer mains shall be
assessed against the lots and tracts of land in the above described
district, specifically benefited thereby in proportion to the
benefits received, to be determined by the City Council as the
law provided.
