ORDINANCE NO. 1317

AN ORDINANCE CREATING WATER CONNECTION DISTRICT NO. 3,
AND PROVIDING FOR A WATER MAIN THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That there is hereby created within the
City, a Water Connection District, to be known as "Water Connection
District No. 3", consisting of property described as follows,
to-wit:


A tract of land in the Juhl Addition to the
City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska,
described as follows: Beginning at the North-
east corner of Lot Sixteen (16), Block Two (2),
Juhl Addition; thence West a distance of Six
Hundred Twenty-one and twenty-five hundredths
feet (621.25'); thence South a distance of Six
Hundred Ten feet (610'); thence East a distance
of Six Hundred Twenty-one and twenty-five
hundredths feet (621.25'); thence North a distance
of Six Hundred Ten feet (610') to the place of
beginning.

Section 2. That six inch (6") cast iron water mains
as ordered by the City Manager shall be laid in said district
running generally north to south down the middle of Wade Street,
Gillan Street, and Erie Street, in accordance with the plans,
specifications, and estimates to be hereinafter adopted.

Section 3. That said Water Connection District is
ordered pursuant to Section 16-6102, Reissue Revised Statutes,
of 1943, as amended; that the cost of said water mains shall not
be levied as a special assessment against the property within
the district, but shall be paid out of a connection fee in the
amount of benefit accruing to the property in the district at
the time such property becomes connected to the water main.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
