

ORDINANCE NO. 1335

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3-6 OF THE CODE; PROVIDING A CHANGE OF HOURS FOR CLOSING OF RETAIL LIQUOR AND BEER STORES, CLOSING OF SUCH STORES ON SUNDAYS AND NAMED HOLIDAYS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Section 3-6 of the Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3-6. Hours of Sale Generally.

1. No person shall sell at retail or dispense any alcoholic liquor, including beer, on the day of any election, including any primary election, within the boundaries of the City when the election is one in which all of the electors of the City may participate in the voting, during the hours the polls are open within the City.

2. No alcoholic liquors, including beer, shall be sold at retail or dispensed on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday, or on Thanksgiving Day and Christmas, between the hours of one o'clock a.m., and one o'clock a.m. the day following.


3. No alcoholic liquors, including beer, shall be sold at retail or dispensed on secular days between one o'clock a.m. and six o'clock a.m.

4. Nothing in this Section shall be construed to prohibit licensed premises from being open for other business on days and hours during which the sale or dispensing of alcoholic liquor is prohibited by this Section.

Section 2. Section 3-6 of the Code as written prior to the passage of this Ordinance, be and the same is hereby repealed.


Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
