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AN ORDINANCE CREATING SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION DISTRICT NO. 70, AND PROVIDING FOR A SEWER THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. There is hereby created within the City of Lexington, a Sanitary Sewer Extension District, to be known as "Sanitary Sewer Extension District No. 70", consisting of property described as follows, to-wit:

A tract of land located in the South Half of the Northwest Quarter (S½ NW¾) of Section Thirtytwo (32), Township Ten (10) North, Range Twenty-one (21) West of the 6th P.M., Dawson County, Nebraska, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Lot One (1), Block One (1), Stuckey's Second Addition to the City of Lexington, thence East parallel to the North line of 20th Street extended to the East, a distance of Two Hundred Ten feet (210'); thence North parallel to the East line of Polk Street extended to the North, a distance of Two Hundred Thirty feet (230'); thence West parallel to the North line of 20th Street extended to the East, a distance of Two Hundred Ten feet (210'); thence North on the West line of Polk Street extended to the North, a distance of One Hundred Fifty feet (150'); thence West, a distance of Nine Hundred Five and five tenths feet (905.5') to the Northeast corner of Lot Sixteen (16), in Indian Heights First Addition; thence South Three Hundred Sixty feet (360') to the Southeast corner of Lot Seventeen (17), Indian Heights First Addition; thence East parallel to the North line of 20th Street, a distance of Nine Hundred Five and five tenths feet (905.5') to the West line of Polk Street extended to the North; thence South, a distance of Twenty feet (20') to the point of beginning.

Section 2. An eight inch (8") V.C.P. sewer main and lift station as ordered by the City Manager shall be laid in the District starting in Apache Drive at the East end of Indian Heights First Addition and running East to the center of Polk Street extended to the North and then running South in Polk Street extended to the North and terminating at the existing manhole located in the alley north of the intersection of 20th Street and Polk Street, which shall be in accordance with plans, specifications, and estimates to be hereinafter adopted.

Section 3. The cost of the sewer main and lift station shall be assessed against the Lots and tracts of land in the above described District, specifically benefited thereby in proportion to the benefits received, to be determined by the City Council as the law provided.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
