## ORDINANCE NO. 1387

AN ORDINANCE CREATING WATER EXTENSION DISTRICT NO. 7
OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA; ESTABLISHING THE OUTER
BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT; DESIGNATING THE SIZE, LOCATION
AND TERMINAL POINTS AND REFERRING TO THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS
AND ESTIMATE OF THE ENGINEER IN CONNECTION THEREWITH ON FILE
WITH THE CITY CLERK; AND ORDERING THE ORDINANCE PUBLISHED IN
PAMPHLET FORM;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. The Mayor and Council of the City of
Lexington, Nebraska, hereby find and determine that it is necessary
and advisable to extend the municipal water service to beyond the
existing system by the construction of water mains, and for the
purpose of constructing said water mains there is hereby created
a Water Extension District No. 7 of the City.

Section 2. The outer boundaries of Water Extension District No. 7 in which it is proposed to make special assessments shall include all of the following described property, to-wit:

Lots Ten (10) through Nineteen (19), inclusive, in Indian Heights Second Addition to the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska.

Section 3. The size, location and terminal points of the water main in said District are as follows, to-wit:

Extension of a 6" asbestos water main commencing at the East line of Indian Heights First Addition and running East to the center of Apache Drive and terminating at the East line of Indian Heights Second Addition.

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that none of the above property is located more than one mile from the City limits and the lots and lands included in Water Extension District No. 7 of Lexington, Nebraska, are located apart and outside any area served and benefited by the existing water works system.

Section 5. Reference is hereby made to the plans and specifications for the water extension which have been prepared by the City Engineer, by order of the Mayor and Council of the City and which, together with the Engineer's estimate of the total cost of the proposed extension, have heretofore been filed with the City Clerk.
